QUICK FACTS

TETRELITE-2 is an early flowering tetraploid (4N) shortlived perennial bunchgrass. This man-made cross of perennial and annual ryegrass is highly aggressive in terms of yield, vigor and regrowth. Tetrelite-2 produces a dense and erect sod and is responsive to increased nitrogen and rainfall. Tetrelite-2 exhibits excellent seedling vigor, tolerates moderately acidic soils and remains productive under poorly drained conditions. For excellent winter growth and persistence, Tetrelite-2 is a top contender.
