





QUICK FACTS: Villa is an elite velvet bentgrass used primarily on golf course putting greens. Villa's turf quality is outstanding and its overall resistance to disease and pests is excellent. It is rated #1 in the 2002 NTEP Trials against brown patch. Villa out performs many other varieties with its abundant summer and fall density, remarkable winter color and fine texture. If you're looking for top quality turf that will be both beautiful and durable all year long, Villa is unsurpassed.

**ADAPTATION:** *Villa* was developed exclusively for golf course greens, tees and fairways; croquet and tennis courts, and bowling tops. *Villa* is also used as a minor component in winter overseed mixtures containing improved Poa Trivialis. *Villa* is well adapted to the Northeastern US and the Pacific Northwest.

SEEDING RATE: 1/2-1 lb. p/1000 sq. ft. (new plantings)
2-3 lbs. p/1000 sq. ft. (interseeding)
[150-220 lbs/ac new plants - 90-150 lbs/ac. interseeding]
