Armada - Kentucky Bluegrass (PSG 366)

combines the spring and fall growth, high density, and shade tolerance of Compact-America type bluegrasses with quick germination and excellent rhizome formation. It has demonstrated excellent performance under a broad range of conditions from home lawns to golf fairways. It is highly recommended for those areas where stem rust during establishment has become an issue.

Armada is particularly well adapted to medium and lower maintenance situations. It is a very dense, low growing variety with a dark green color and medium fine leaf texture. Armada tolerates mowing heights down to 1/2 inch, and the quick establishment makes Armada ideal for repairs on all bluegrass sites.

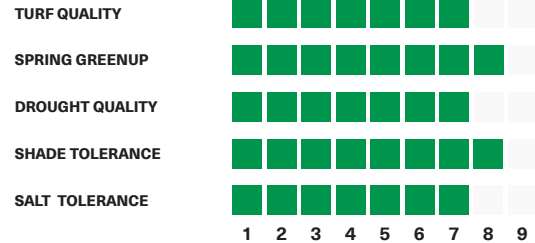
With its combination of excellent turf quality, disease resistance, combined with top scores for early spring green up, Armada is a great choice for parks, golf courses, and home lawns.

For overall disease resistance, Armada stands out. Trial data has shown Armada to have excellent resistance to Dollar Spot, Stem Rust, Pink Snow Mold, and Leaf Spot.
