Blue Ghost - Kentucky Bluegrass (PST K9-103)

is a unique Kentucky Bluegrass derived from two species and multiple types of Kentucky bluegrass. The mother traces to Midnight crossed with Poa secunda (Big bluegrass, native to United States and Canada); the father traces to multiple bluegrass types. Seedlings from the cross were screened at 6,000-20,000 ppm salt. Blue Ghost was selected from the survivors. Blue Ghost is quick to establish even under adverse conditions. It forms a high quality turf that is persistent under a broad range of weather and soil conditions.

Blue Ghost is widely adaptable from Northern areas into the Transition Zone and from East to West. It does well in alkaline and acid soils and blends well with other grasses. Blue Ghost is the key to genetic diversity in turf applications.
