Eureka II - Hard Fescue

is a deep dark green, dense, slow growing bunch grass that spreads slowly with basal tillering. Once fully established, it requires little supplemental irrigation or fertilizer and tolerates acidic, infertile shady planting sites.

Eureka II can be used for unmown meadows to home lawns, or fairways. Eureka II is best utilized in polyspecies turf-grass mixtures for improved shade tolerance, reduced mowing requirement and reduced maintenance. With a dark green color it is compatible with Kentucky bluegrass, perennial ryegrass, colonial bentgrass and other fine fescues. It is excellent under reduced inputs.
