ABUNDANT is a tetraploid annual ryegrass that has larger leaves, a higher water content, and better palatability than many diploid varieties. Abundant will produce high quality feed for use as pasture, hay or silage. It was bred for vigor, disease resistance, and high performance. It is highly resistant to the major forage diseases including crown and leaf rust, leaf spot/scald, powdery mildew, and pythium blight.
